C. Rodger Wilson Leadership Conference

October 29-30, 2010

The fall 2010 C. Rodger Wilson Leadership Conference (CRWLC) will be held October 29-30, on the campus of The University of Massachusetts at Boston. Boston Alumni Chapter and Chi Chapter will be the Conference hosts.

The fee is \$225 per Alumni Chapter. The cost covers the chapter's Polemarch, Keeper of Records, Keeper of Exchequer, Historian, Reporter, Chapter Advisor, and MIOP Chairman. There is a \$75 fee per Collegiate chapter. The cost covers the Polemarch, Keeper of Records, Keeper of Exchequer and MIOP Chairman, who are all required to attend. If the brother who holds that office is unable to attend, someone from the chapter must attend in his place. Failure to have all officers in attendance will affect

your chapter's certification status (which will affect your chapters ability to hold membership intake).

The conference will begin at 7:00 PM sharp on Friday evening (with officer workshops).

Please note that the second packet of (your chapter's) certification information is due at this meeting. Please contact one of your Province Regional Board Members if there are any questions regarding any of the information due from the list.

The Province has secured a \$129 room rate at the Hampton Inn & Suites Boston Crosstown Center (617) 445-6400. This rate includes all hotel taxes and parking.

Secondly, the customary \$300 donation from each alumni chapter (to support sending our undergraduate officers to Grand Chapter meeting) is due this year as well. The Province will accept payments at the CRWLC for chapters who are able to pay at that time.

National Founders Day - January 8, 2010 Philadelphia, PA

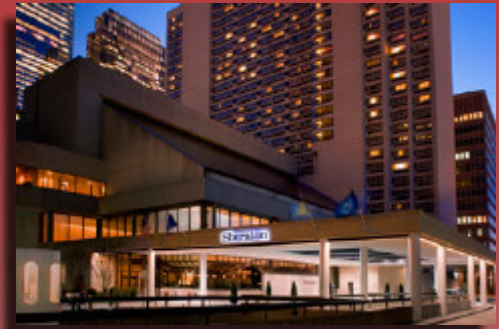
